 - Just add them to their new classroom (environment)

Currently Enrolled Children: If this child WAS enrolled during the prior year, the information entered on this demographic form for the current year should reflect their status as of July 1 of the current year.

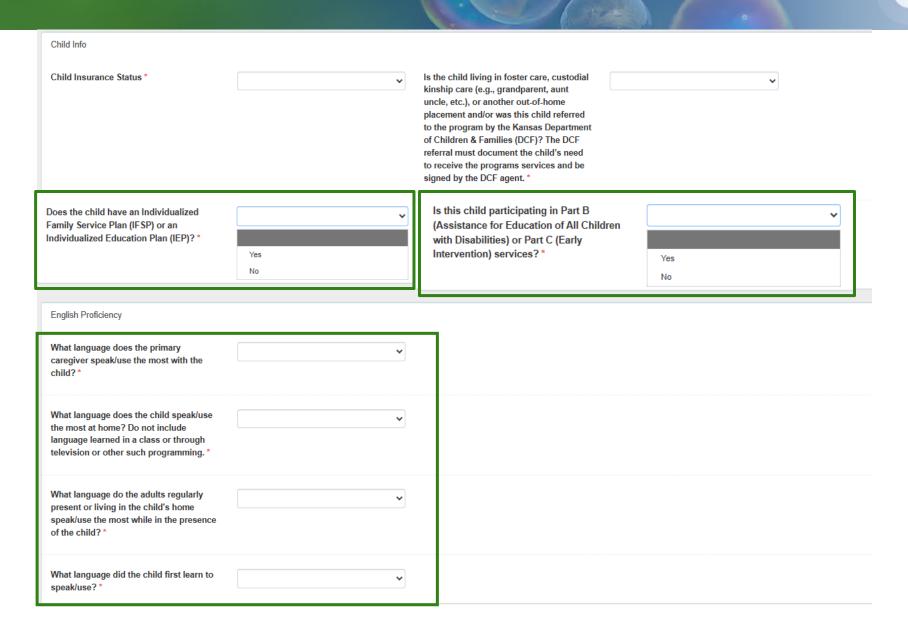

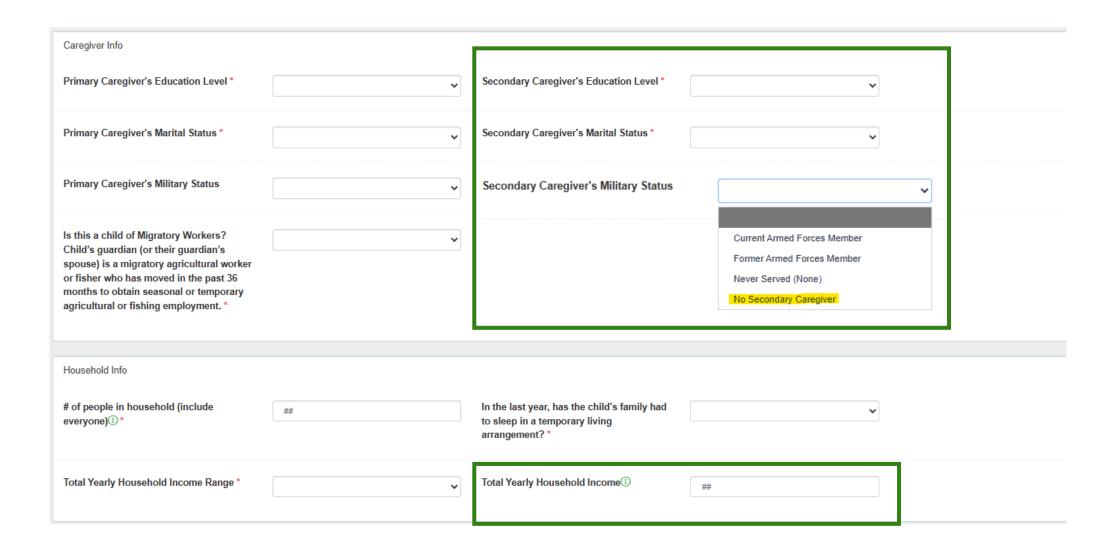

DAISEY INPUT BY MEASURE

DAISEY Entry Deadlines: December 31st & May 31st



MYIGDI AUTOMATIC DATA TRANSFER

- Enter Profiles into Renaissance & DAISEY
 - Make sure birth dates and mylGDI IDs match in both places
- 2. Assess children
- Manually enter assessment scores for Numeracy into Renaissance
 - Will also need to manually enter Literacy+ into Renaissance if not administering with the iPad

- 4. Data will transfer from Renaissance to DAISEY every Sunday night
- 5. Check DAISEY on Monday to make sure the scores pulled into DAISEY.
