


Accessing IGDI-APEL (Age 3 IGDIs) August 2024

The IGDI-APEL application houses IGDIs measures in English and Spanish. It transitioned to a new progressive web app (PWA) as of the 2024-2025 school year.

IGDI-APEL should be downloaded on two devices. It can be downloaded on 2 iPads or 1 iPad and 1 laptop. Instructions for both iPads and **Google Chrome** are below using an example from the CDC.

iPad

1. Go to <https://app.igdi-item-test.com/> using a web browser
2. Press the “Share” button and select “Add to Home Screen” from the popup.
3. Tap “Add” in the top right corner.




4. The app will now be on your home screen




Laptop

1. Go to <https://app.igdi-item-test.com/> using the Chrome browser
2. Locate the icon on the right side of the URL bar. Click the icon and then click the “install” button. This will add the application to your computer.



On your iPad, the icon will show up just like any other app.



Click or Tap the icon and login with your email and password. This will be the email and password submitted for the classroom(s) you will be teaching, assessing or administering.



Start Screening

On the student iPad, open the app and tap **Switch to Student View** in the bottom right.



Type the four-letter code on the student app into the **Assignment Details** popup window on the assessor's device. Then click the blue **Connect** button.



Both devices need to be connected to the internet. They don't have to be on the same network, if both have access to the internet.

Tap/Click **Connect to a Different Device** to assess a student on another iPad.

Close the Assignment Details window by tapping the X in the top right. Then you can switch classrooms by clicking the gray **Change** button beneath the School – Classroom name.

Additional Notes:

- This is a web app, so it can be used inside the browser.
- If during a measure, the response from the student is lagging, or items are delayed in showing up, check the internet connection for both devices. A slow internet for either device will cause lag time.
- If either the student or assessment/teach app freezes, shut it down by either closing it on the laptop, or swiping it off the screen on the iPad when showing all the running apps. Then make sure the network is still connected to the internet.
- You can tap the **Switch to Assessor View** in the bottom right corner when inside the
